The Performance Enhancement Program (PEP) and the remedial program enable the student to bridge the learning gap and maintain the minimum learning levels (MLL) at different stages. The system is especially designed to interpret the data and to accurately analyse the performance of each student.



PROGRAM ON INTENSIVE ENGLISH (PIE)

The program helps our overseas students to improve their english speaking, reading and writing skills before they join the mainstream group of IGCSE. The program starts from grade VIII, where students are streamlined for IB, ICSE & IGCSE. In addition to learning English and Hindi, students are also taught Sanskrit and French from the primary years.

ENGLISH FOR SPEAKERS OF OTHER LANGUAGE (ESOL)
