With new prayers, guests on campus, SPIC MACAY reviving, and our girls learning to survive in the harsh world, we hope the best for the school!

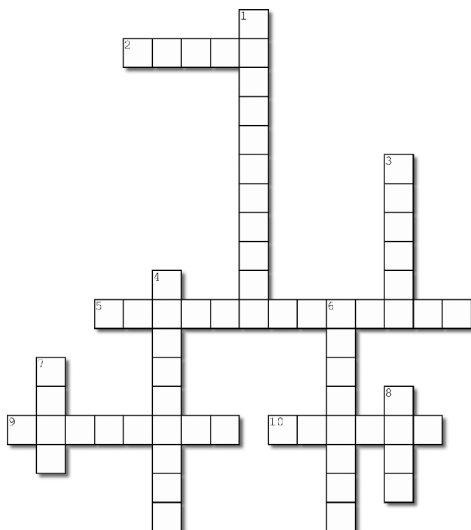
