# CHINA IN 2020: TOO PROBLEMATIC?

From the ongoing Hong Kong protests to the global pandemic originating from China, it looks like China has caused enough disputes for the year 2020. However, an important topic, the majority of the population is missing out, is the forced labour used from the minority ethnic groups in major brands. In March 2020, the Australian Strategic Policy Institute (ASPI) published a report which revealed 83 Chinese and foreign companies as allegedly benefiting – either directly or indirectly, from forced labour by the minority ethnic Muslim group called "Uyghur". So, what is exactly happening? Members of this minority group are being shifted from their homes to factories for suppliers of multinationals under strict forced labour. Living in guarded dormitories with very little freedom, these workers are assigned tasks which they cannot refuse. Not only are they restricted from practising their religions but also communication with their families is limited and monitored. Research manifested that around 80,000 Uyghurs have been forced into this. The 83 so far identified brands benefiting from this include: Apple, Adidas/Fila, Amazon, BMW, Google, H&M, HP, Microsoft, Nike, Puma, Samsung, Skechers, Sony, Vivo, Oppo, Gap, Huawei, Nintendo, Panasonic, Tommy Hilfiger, Victoria's Secret, Volkswagen, Zara, and many more. These companies, however, now plan on taking action owing to the ASPI report.

## **EVEN THE CHURCH IS NOT SAFE?**

While the world tries to recover from the 'pandemic situation', South Africa is dealing with the 'hostage situation'. The International Pentecostal Holiness Church in Johannesburg, South Africa suffered an attack by a group of aggressors belonging to a splinter group, on the 11th of July 2020. A total of five people were shot and burned alive by these assailants. The combined forces of Military and Police reacted immediately to the firing and discovered four people 'shot and burned to death' in a car. Along with them, a security guard in another car and six people who were brutally injured were found. The Militia stated that around 200 men, women and children were rescued after being held hostage by the aggressors, in the church's main building. The police

were successful in arresting about 40 attackers and also confiscated firearms including, five rifles, sixteen shotguns, thirteen pistols, baseball bats, and more ammunition. Besides that, research conducted by the Militia proved that members of the 'South Africa Police Services', defence forces and correctional services, were also a part of the arrested. This was not the first time that a church has faced an assault. It is claimed that bullets have been shot, rocks thrown and cars smashed every year since their former leader 'Glayton Modise' died in

February 2016.

FGM, Female Genital Mutilation, is a monumentally discriminatory practice that results in the partial or total elimination of external female genitalia without any medical reasons. It violates many aspects of international human rights law relating to women and children. Nearly nine out of ten women in Sudan aged 15-49 have undergone mutilation. This practice is firmly imbued with the cultural beliefs of the country, making it difficult to eradicate. Yet, in the past few years, a change in the people's mindset has gained momentum. Sudan's new government -CAIRO- has banned the practice of female genital mutilation. This movement was hailed as a major achievement by women's rights activists, for they live in a world where the sometimes fatal practice is endemic. Now, the crime of female genital mutilation is punishable by a possible three-year prison term and fine under an amendment of the country's criminal code, approved by its transitional government. Although this is a crucial step made by the Sudanese government to conserve women's rights, it cannot completely eradicate the practice. The very idea of FGM is imprinted onto the Sudanese's beliefs. Sudan's lawmakers are no doubt, headed in the right direction but the obstacle they must face now is blind faith.


