

PERFORMANCE ENHANCEMENT PROGRAM (PEP)

AT MIS, daily creative assessments are integrated into every subject in order to identify the strengths and limitations of each student. The Performance Enhancement Program (PEP) and the Remedial program allow to bridge the learning gap and to maintain the Minimum Learning Levels (MLL) of each student. The system is specially designed to interpret the data and to accurately analyze the performance of each student.

PROGRAM ON INTENSIVE ENGLISH (PIE)

The program helps our overseas students to improve their English speaking, reading and writing skills before they join the mainstream group of IGCSE. The program starts from grade VIII, where students are streamlined for both ICSE & IGCSE. In addition to learning English and Hindi, students are also taught Sanskrit and French from the primary years.

ESOL - English for speakers of other languages, are comprehensively and scientifically designed with the purpose of taking learning beyond classrooms, through activities such as games, drama, audio and visual clips which makes learning enjoyable and participating.




SPORTS & FITNESS


